The 7th Pan Pacific Masters Games will be held from 6 to 14 November 2010 on the beautiful Gold Coast. There will be 34 sports on the program, with more than 10,000 people from all over the world expected to participate.

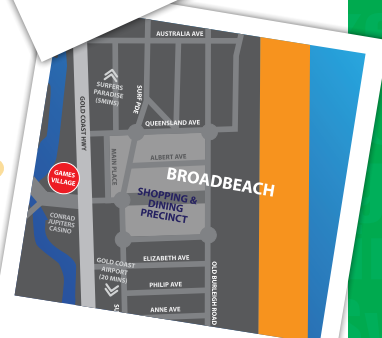

Additional Information

- Participants must hold a current firearms licence.
- Participants must produce a current licence from their home state or country of residence when attending a licensed range in Queensland, to be permitted to shoot.
- Participants will be required to record their daily attendance in the range register.
- Grades will be confirmed by the Gold Coast Clay Target Club (GCCTC) and the Australian Clay Target Association (ACTA). Grade percentages will be applied to overseas visitors.
- Participants are required to present their handicap card to the organisers on their first day of competition.
- Standard fluorescent red targets will be used for Trap, standard black for Skeet and both fluorescent red and black in various sizes for Sporting.
- International participants can obtain information on importing firearms and download the necessary application forms from the Queensland Police website www.police.qld.gov.au

- A comprehensive range of ammunition will be available at the Club.
- Meals and refreshments can be purchased at the Club on competition days.
- Competitions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the ACTA.
- Competitions are conducted by the GCCTC under the auspices of the Queensland Clay Target Association and the ACTA.
